



Amy's Story: Local giving to JF&CS funds lifelines for family in need

Amy's daughter was born with unexpected health issues. In that moment, everything changed for Amy and her husband.



Amy left her job to stay home and take care of their baby girl. The couple knew this would be a stretch financially. But they had to put the needs of their daughter first.

Before long, Amy and her husband began to **struggle to pay their rent**. And after missing four months, their landlord started the eviction process. Amy didn't know what to do.

Fortunately, she was already getting help from a JF&CS **Visiting Mom** who'd been a lifeline to Amy since she gave birth. And the Visiting Mom knew exactly who to call at JF&CS for support. All free of charge, thanks to our generous community of donors.

Amy received **pro bono legal assistance**, another lifeline made possible by the generosity of people like you. Your support also allowed Amy's family to receive **groceries from our kosher food pantry** that offers a lifeline to the hungry.

JF&CS staff helped Amy get **fuel assistance** and discounts on other utilities. And, they worked with Amy's husband to figure out a plan for employment where he could bring their daughter to work. This changed everything, allowing Amy to return to work also.

But, one major problem remained – they couldn't pay the arrearage owed on their apartment. This left the whole family at risk for ending up homeless.

Once again, our family of supporters came to the rescue with another lifeline. Help from donors and partner agencies enabled JF&CS to provide an **emergency grant**. This gave Amy's family enough money to pay what they owed and avoid eviction.

Thanks to many lifelines from the JF&CS community and Amy's perseverance, her family is back on their feet and doing great. And her little girl is thriving!


